Thought for the Week

Winston Churchill once said, "courage is going from failure to failure without losing enthusiasm. The thing about dreaming big for the Lord is that there is not always a perfect outcome. We *will* have disappointments, we *will* make mistakes, we *will* have heartache and we *will* fail sometimes. But let's not forget, **God is on our side**. He never leaves us and He will give us courage to keep on going and to keep picking ourselves back up when we get knocked down.
